MODULE TITLE: ENVIRONMENTAL ART	
MODULE DESCRIPTION: Students explore the natural environment from a different perspective and take inspiration from artists such as Andy Goldsworthy to create a piece of art either about themselves, their experiences or the environment around them. Students may create a piece of art using only natural materials found in the local area, re-using litter or other natural materials (e.g. clay).
